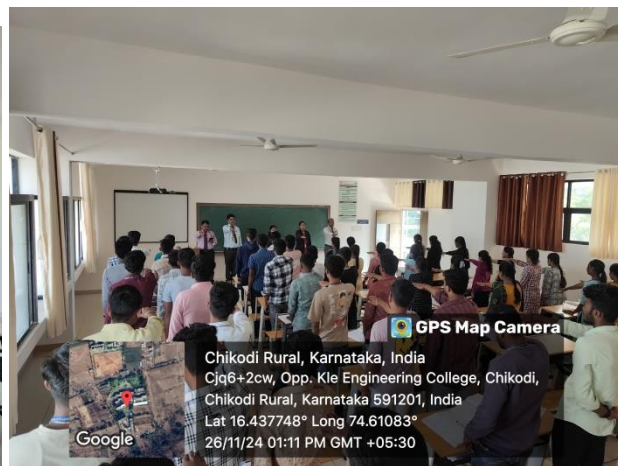

A Report on Indian Constitution Day

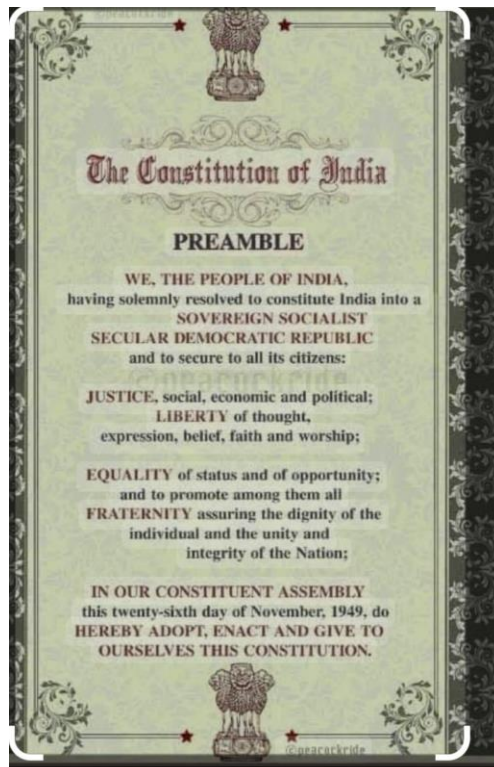
