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#### **Student Feedback Procedure:**

The feedback is collected two times in a semester one at 4-5 weeks after the semester starts and second at the end of semester to understand the depth of the knowledge, related subjects by the students.

- 1 The academic credentials such as punctuality, follow of lesson plan, class preparation, and explanation in the class are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 2 The teacher give opportunity for questions and discussions, continuity from class to class are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 3 The teacher motivates to study subject in depth, correlation the syllabus completed and exam pattern are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 4 The language of the teacher and usage of time for relevant/useful topics are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 5 The teacher's control and command over the class and teacher availability outside classroom for doubts clearing are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 6 The attitude of the teacher towards students and teacher favouritism to some students are measured in the scale of 2 to 8.
- 7 Detailed feedback analysis is done and average is calculated for all parameters.
  - a) If the feedback average is less than 6, faculty will be counselled by HOD.
  - b) If feedback average is less than 75% then faculty has to give explanation in writing for the questions whose average is less than 75%.

#### Efficiency of feedback system:

The feedback system developed by the institute has found to be good and it is observed that 95% of faculty members of Department have feedback average above 85%.

#### **System of reward process:**

After the detailed analysis of feedback, the faculties are issued a letter of appreciation by the head of the department for achieving excellence in teaching.

#### **Corrective measures:**

- The faculty concerned will be counselled by HOD and Principal, with regard to the preparation of the subject, student class control etc. and advice the faculty to improve.
- Promoting and encouraging faculty to attend the faculty development programs (FDP) related to effective teaching methodologies.
